Tasting Note:	The 2021 UV Vineyard Chardonnay is 100% Old Wente Chardonnay Clone. Aromatics of mineral, orange blossom, tangerine, ginger, blanched almond. Great density and energy. A very bright, intense palate with Asian pear, citrus - tangerine, light zest, brioche, Meyer lemon. Effortlessly balanced, a touch of phenolics drives a long finish.
