Tasting Note:	On the nose, black cherry mixes with fresh crushed blackberries and blueberry, with a hint of fresh asphalt and tar. The wine is full and rich on the palate, showing focused structure outlining bold dark fruits and savory blood-iron, cedar, spice, delicate lavender lingers on the finish. A focused and energetic Rhone red wine of Syrah & Grenache.
